"My belongings were destroyed in a fire. When I left the burning building, my therapist at SMHA suggested that I contact CLRP. CLRP advocated for three other residents of my apartment. They also got their belongings back and it was a big relief to us. Without CLRP's assistance, I would not have been able to replace all the needed items that were lost in the fire. I was pretty desperate but CLRP stepped in and did good work on my behalf."
